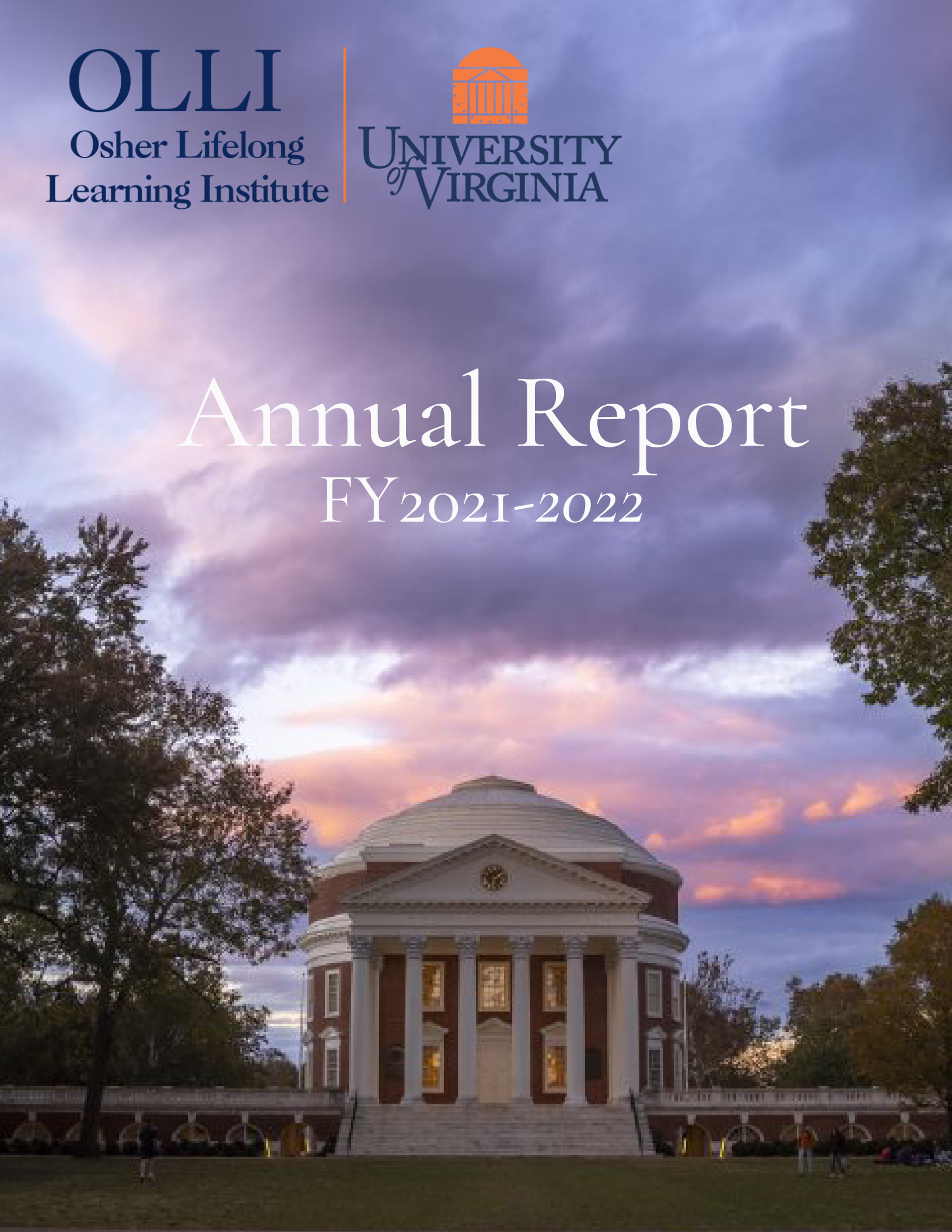

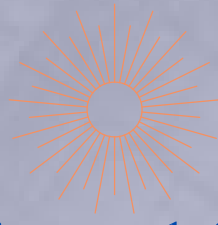

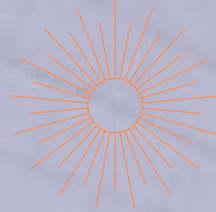


Year in Review

Our OLLI community

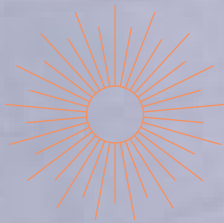


OLLI at UVA is made up of:

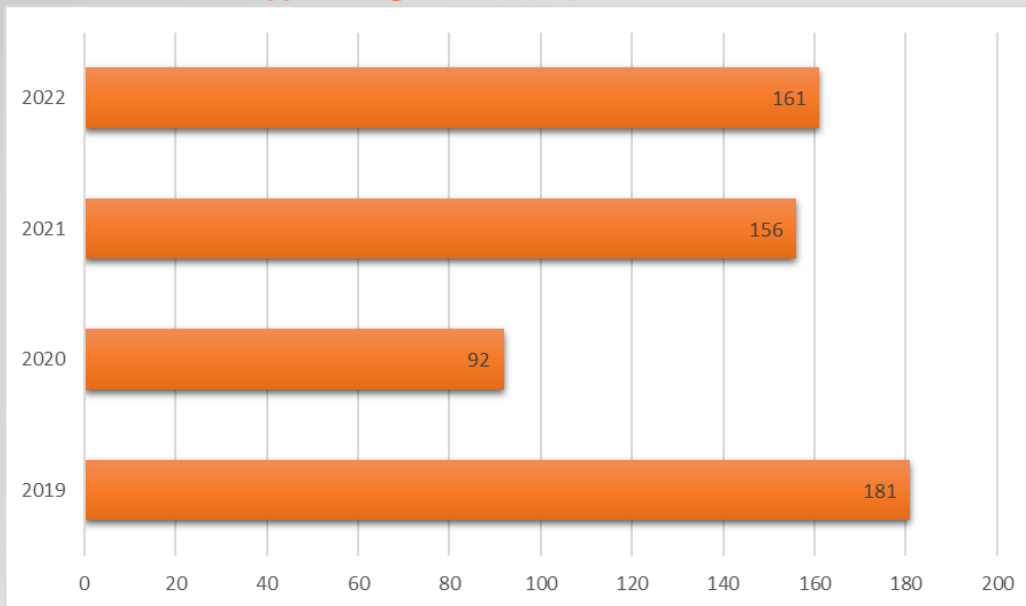

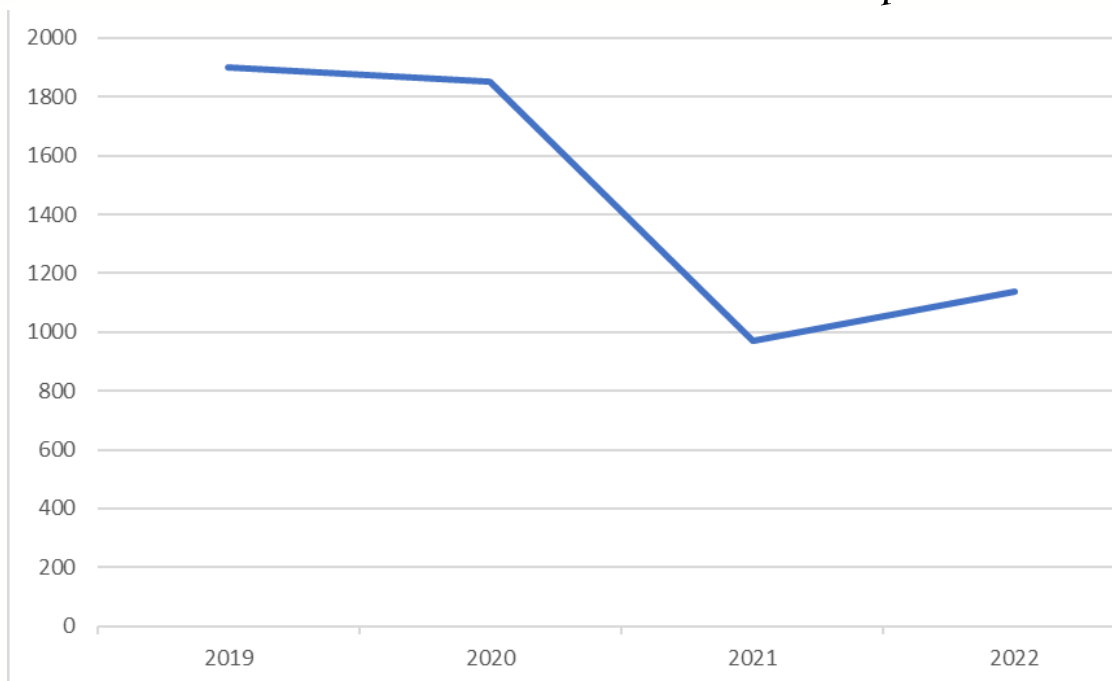
OLLI at Glance FY19-FY22

Course Offerings FY2019-FY2022



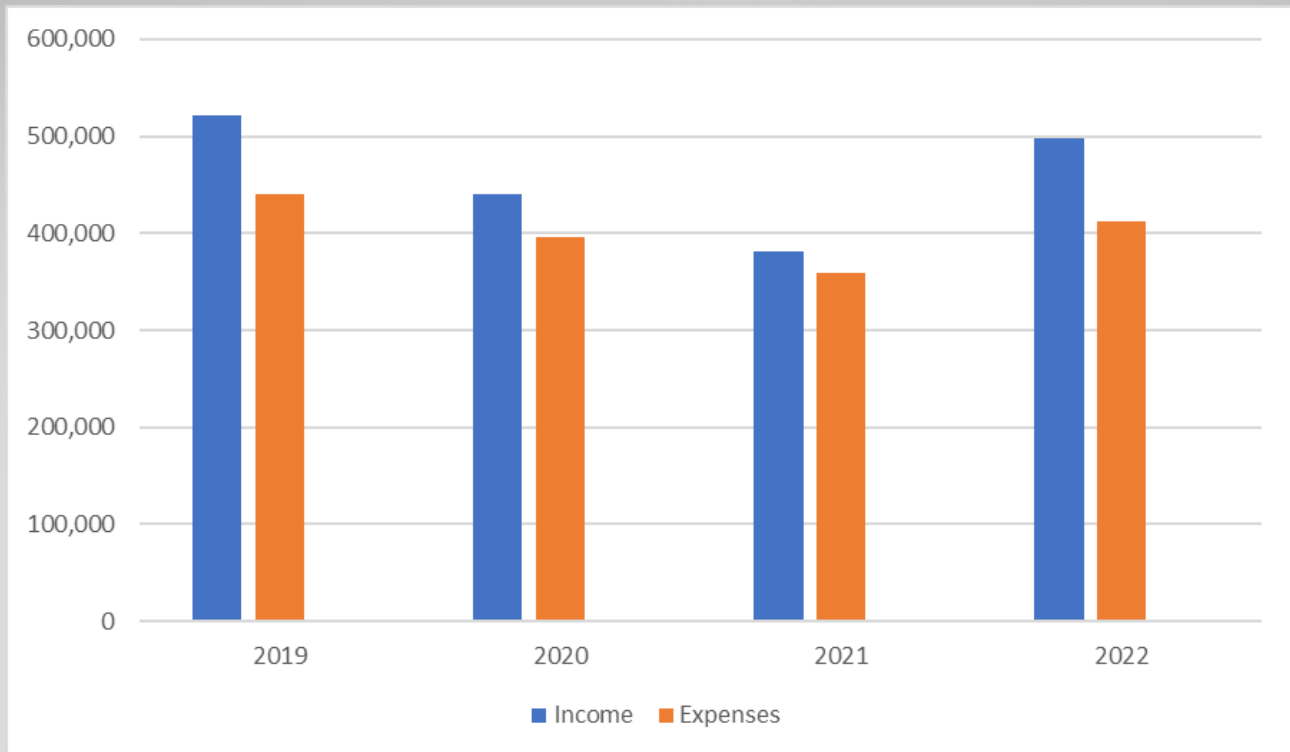

Membership FY2019-FY2022



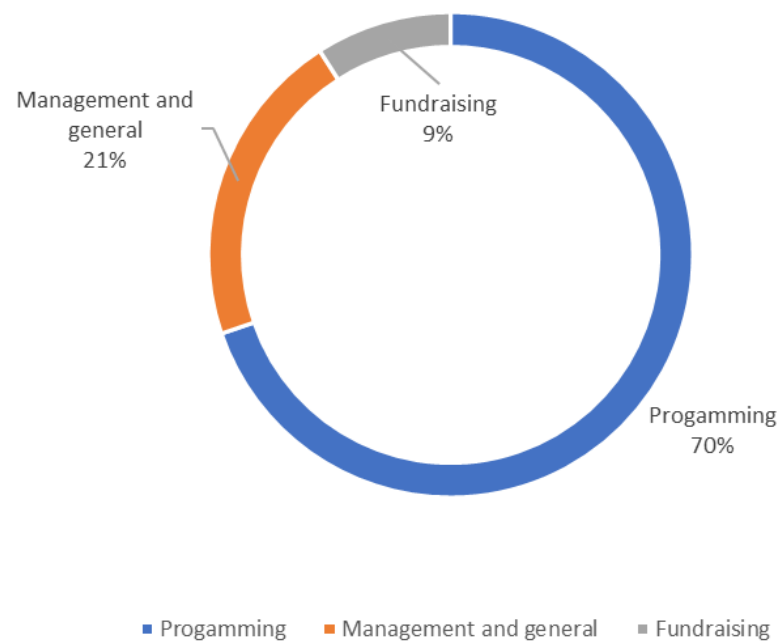
