

We wanted to take a moment to address a common question since we began courses via Zoom virtually during the Fall of 2020. Within OLLI at UVA, we do not record our Zoom or virtual course sessions for a few reasons listed below:

- **Privacy** -- Each participant's face and name are displayed on the screen and would appear on the recording. OLLI is committed to protecting our members' privacy.
- **Copyright** -- Due to OLLI's educational status, instructors are permitted to use copyrighted material in class and special presentations, as long as credit is given. However, if virtual lectures were recorded and the information was shared beyond OLLI's control, there could be potential copyright issues.
- **Inclusion** -- For a virtual meeting to be recorded, each participant must agree to be recorded. However, some may not agree and would have to leave the meeting, which would not be fair to all members.
- **Webinars** -- OLLI records some of our special presentations that run in a webinar format because participants are not shown on the screen and the presenter has approved all materials for recordings.
